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1. Details of operating results

(1) Details of operating results

The economic environment during the current interim consolidated accounting period remains uncertain, with concerns persisting over the continued global inflation, persistently high long-term interest rates, the slowdown in China's economic growth, and the impact of U.S. tariff policies on the global economy as a whole.

Capital investment in manufacturing equipment related to our group's overall operations shows signs of caution in some areas due to uncertainty surrounding future prospects stemming from tariff policies and other factors. Furthermore, while the global trend toward decarbonization is expected to continue over the medium to long term, the review of decarbonization policies in the United States is highly likely to impact global decarbonization policies, increasing uncertainty for corporate capital investment in the short term.

Amidst these circumstances, Fiscal 2025 marks the fifth year of our ongoing Mid-Term Management Plan (FY2021-2026). We are further advancing the establishment of collaborative and co-creation frameworks and mechanisms aimed at creating customer value and increasing our customer base, which have been our focus to date. Simultaneously, to differentiate our products and services and enhance our competitiveness in the market, we are pursuing activities aimed at further advancing our "Loop Solution," which integrates temperature-centric products, technologies, and know-how.

Net sales increased year on year, driven by growth in the Instrumentation Systems segment and the Sensors segment. Regionally, sales increased year on year, primarily in the Asia region and domestically.

Orders received increased year on year across all segments, with demand particularly rising in the Sensors segment. Note that orders received and net sales in the Instrumentation Systems segment are influenced by the timing of orders and delivery schedules within the fiscal year, affecting the company's overall year on year quarterly fluctuations.

In terms of profitability, earnings declined compared to the same period last year. While the Sensors segment saw a significant year on year increase in profits, the Instrumentation Systems segment was impacted by lower-than-expected profit margins on several individual projects recorded in the first quarter.

As a result, orders received during the interim period totaled 14,378 million yen (up 11.2% year on year), and net sales reached 14,187 million yen (up 7.8% year on year). Regarding profits, Operating profit was 917 million yen (down 14.0% year on year), Ordinary profit was 960 million yen (down 16.0% year on year), and Profit attributable to owners of parent was 468 million yen (down 26.1% year on year).

Please note that our Group's net sales and profits tend to be concentrated at the end of the fiscal year, and quarterly net sales and profits tend to deviate significantly from the full-year results.

Results by segment are as follows.

1) Measurement & Control Instruments

Net sales amounted to 4,620 million yen (down 5.4% year on year), and Segment profit was 699 million yen (down 2.1% year on year). Regarding net sales, domestic demand remained firm, primarily for semiconductor and electronic component manufacturing equipment and heat treatment processing. However, net sales decreased year on year due to a temporary decline in demand in China.

Additionally, regarding profits, they decreased year on year primarily due to the impact of reduced revenue.

2) Instrumentation Systems

Net sales amounted to 4,532 million yen (up 13.9% year on year), while Segment profit was 213 million yen (down 62.9% year on year). Net sales increased year on year, primarily driven by sales of compressor performance testing systems compatible with natural refrigerants that have low global warming potential.

Profit declined compared to the same period last year. As mentioned above, the deterioration in profit margins for specific projects impacted the segment's overall profit.

3) Sensors

Net sales reached 4,502 million yen (up 18.4% year on year), while Segment profit was 937 million yen (up 42.5% year on year). Sales increased year on year due to steady demand for semiconductor and electronic component manufacturing equipment. Furthermore, sales of marine Temperature Sensors and other products manufactured and sold by our group company MEIYO ELECTRIC Co.,Ltd. remained strong.

In terms of profits, mainly due to the effect of increased revenue, profits rose compared to the same period last year.

4) Others

Net sales amounted to 531 million yen (up 6.9% year on year), and Segment profit reached 136 million yen (up 36.2% year on year).

(2) Details of financial position

(Assets)

Total assets at the end of the interim consolidated accounting period decreased by 1,515 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year, amounting to 36,250 million yen.

Current assets decreased by 2,196 million yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year, totaling 25,072 million yen. The main factors contributing to this decrease were a decrease of 1,446 million yen in trade receivables, a decrease of 591 million yen in cash and deposits, and a decrease of 223 million yen in inventories.

Non-current assets increased by 681 million yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year, reaching 11,178 million yen. The main factors contributing to this increase were a 414 million yen increase in Property, plant and equipment and a 220 million yen increase in investments and other assets.

(Liabilities)

Total liabilities at the end of the interim consolidated accounting period decreased by 1,585 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year, amounting to 11,145 million yen.

Current liabilities decreased by 1,271 million yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year, totaling 8,119 million yen. The main factors contributing to this change were a decrease of 847 million yen in Other (Current liabilities), a decrease of 239 million yen in the provision for bonuses, a decrease of 197 million yen in income taxes payable, a decrease of 123 million yen in electronically recorded obligations - facilities, and an increase of 200 million yen in trade payables.

Non-current liabilities decreased by 314 million yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year, totaling 3,026 million yen. The main factors contributing to this decrease were a 236 million yen reduction in long-term borrowings and a 104 million yen decrease in Other (Non-current liabilities).

(Net assets)

Total net assets at the end of the interim period increased by 70 million yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year, reaching 25,104 million yen. The main factors contributing to this change were an increase of 468 million yen in Profit attributable to owners of parent, an increase of 133 million yen in accumulated other comprehensive income, and a decrease of 467 million yen due to dividends paid.

(3) Details of cash flows

1) Cash flows from operating activities

Cash flows from operating activities for the interim period increased by 1,621 million yen (compared to an increase of 1,045 million yen in the same period of the previous fiscal year). This increase resulted from cash inflows, such as profit before income taxes and other adjustments of 953 million yen and a decrease in trade receivables of 1,406 million yen, which exceeded cash outflows, such as income taxes paid of 598 million yen and a decrease in advances received of 342 million yen.

2) Cash flows from investing activities

Cash flows from investing activities for the interim period resulted in a net decrease of 830 million yen (compared to a net decrease of 379 million yen in the same period of the previous fiscal year). This decrease was primarily due to expenditures of 1,201 million yen for the purchase of property, plant and equipment, which exceeded the increase in cash of 546 million yen from the withdrawal of time deposits.

3) Cash flows from financing activities

Cash flows from financing activities during the interim period resulted in a net decrease of 880 million yen (compared to a net decrease of 673 million yen in the same period of the previous fiscal year), primarily due to dividends paid of 467 million yen and repayments of long-term borrowings of 236 million yen.

As a result, the balance of Cash and cash equivalents at the end of the interim period decreased by 161 million yen compared to 7,575 million yen at the end of the previous fiscal year, ending at 7,414 million yen.

There are no changes to the consolidated earnings forecast for the fiscal year ending March 2026 (full year) from the figures announced on May 13, 2025.
