2. Reason

We regard returning profits to our shareholders as one of our top management priorities. Phase 2 (FY2024–FY2026) covers the final three years of our medium-term management plan (covering the six-year period from FY2021 to FY2026), our basic policy is to achieve dividend growth through sustainable profit growth, with the goal of raising the consolidated dividend payout ratio to 40% by the final year (FY2026) of Phase 2 (FY2024 to FY2026).

We have decided to set the year-end dividend for the fiscal year ended March 2026 at 30 yen per share, based on the above policy and the consolidated results and financial position announced on May 14, 2026.
